Piedmont Regional Dental Clinic to Offer Free Dental Services to Underinsured and Uninsured Adults

WHAT: Missions of Mercy (MOM) Piedmont Regional Dental Day.

A free one-day dental clinic for underinsured and uninsured Central Virginia patients of all ages. All patients will receive at least one of the following services:

- Preventative Dentistry (teeth cleanings, fluoride application, sealants, oral hygiene, nutritional counseling).
- Restorative Dentistry (fillings).
- Extractions.

WHO: Local dentists, dental hygienists, volunteers, and 500-600 underinsured or uninsured patients. All dental services will be furnished by fully accredited dentists, dental hygienists, or supervised student volunteers.

WHERE: The Barboursville Fire House

WHEN: Saturday, May 1, 2010, 5:30 a.m. Those who wish to receive service are encouraged to pre-register at the Barboursville Fire House on Friday, April 30 at 2 p.m.

All patients who pre-register on Friday will be given a wristband and should arrive by 5:30 a.m. on Saturday. Participants with wristbands will be directed to a wristband express line. Services will be provided on a first-come/first-served basis to the first 500-600 patients who arrive on Saturday. A wristband guarantees service only to patients who are among the first 500-600 to arrive on Saturday.
